Young Entrepreneurs Association from Romania was founded in 2005 following the model of the Young Entrepreneurs of the European Union – JEUNE, the youth organisation of the European Union. Young Entrepreneurs Association from Romania is the only employer organization that represents at national and European level the interests of young entrepreneurs aged between 18 and 40, and it comprises 8 regional structures. YEAR's objectives have a strong social strand, stimulating and promoting entrepreneurship among young people, ensuring their access to information and knowhow about the socio-economic functioning of a company, developing policies for young people, in general, and young entrepreneurs, in particular. Between 2011 and 2014, YEAR's President also held the Presidency of the Young Entrepreneurs of the European Union – JEUNE, an organization with over 300.000 members, representing young entrepreneurs across Europe.
